New York Democrats Want to Preserve Records of Bad Behavior at ICE - Last month, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) asked NARA to reduce the time required to maintain documents related to law enforcement activity, including solitary confinement and deaths in custody. New York Democrats are calling out against these measures. Without proper monitoring of such records, what misconduct by law enforcement could fall through the cracks?

### **New York Archives Week**

It's time once again to get ready for New York Archives Week! October 18-25, institutions across the city will open their doors to the public with tours, demonstrations, and talks, all to show the importance of preserving the past and making it available for future generations.

Here's a look at some of the programs planned by A.R.T. for the occasion:

Thursday, October 19th - A.R.T. will host an all-day symposium on Archives and Local History. Panels, discussions, and other programs taking place will focus on archives at the community level, including community records and local historical societies among other topics.

Saturday, October 21st - The annual K-12

Archives Education Institute will be at the National Archives. K-12 instructors can learn how to incorporate primary sources in their instruction, while archivists can learn how to connect their artifacts with Common Core and state requirements.

**Tuesday, October 24th** - At the Annual Awards Ceremony, the roundtable will honor colleagues for their contribution to A.R.T. and the archival profession throughout the year.
